Atlanta Rowing Club Membership Fees

Fees:

Regular memberships are for **ONE** calendar year, January through December; please see our website (www.atlantarow.org) for descriptions of the various membership categories.

New members pay the following charges upon joining the Atlanta Rowing Club (see table on next page for the exact amounts for the respective membership categories):

1. Annual membership fee
2. Initiation fee – half due at joining and the other half due the following year when dues are paid
3. Maintenance fee

The annual fee is half the regular amount for new members joining on or after September 1st.

Work Credit:

A work credit may be given at the beginning of a member's second calendar year and subsequent years. Work credit is earned by accumulating at least 8 hours in ARC work parties, helping with Learn to Row classes, or through other board-approved work (including serving on the board or on a board committee). This work must be completed and documented. Work is performed in one year and credit is given the following year. Note that 8 hours is required for each family member who belongs to ARC (e.g. if a Family membership is 2 adults, 16 hours is required).

Head of the Hooch Volunteering:

All ARC members are asked to volunteer a minimum of six (6) hours at the "Head of the Hooch" Regatta, held the first weekend in November each year; anyone rowing in more than one race is required to volunteer an additional two (2) hours. If a member volunteers more than eight (8) hours at the Hooch, those hours in excess of eight are counted toward a member's Work Credit.

This regatta is ARC's only club fund-raiser. ARC members who do not volunteer will owe a Hooch volunteering fee of \$10 per hour for each hour that they are required to volunteer but choose not to. This will alleviate the costs of paying for other qualified workers when ARC members choose not to volunteer.

New Member Orientation:

Note that all new members are required to attend a 1-hour orientation session to ensure a clear understanding of the ARC safety and boat use processes before they are allowed to use club equipment. These sessions will be held monthly.
